

Children's Unsafe Behaviours – Parental Responsibility

Policy

Lions Emergency Accommodation Centre Inc. (LEAC) is committed to providing a safe environment for all clients of the Service.

Procedure

Each parent is responsible for ensuring their children do not engage in dangerous or disruptive behaviours which impact adversely on the safety and well being of others in the Service.

When staff observe or are informed of dangerous or disruptive behaviours by children a staff member will talk with the parent about the behaviour and the need for change.

Staff will assist parents with strategies and/or appropriate referrals to address the behaviours and support the parent to implement change.

If a parent refuses or is unwilling to intervene and the behaviour continues, they will be warned that any future occurrences will result in the family being requested to leave.
